Workshop: Local Industry/Employer Visit

Rationale

- o A visit to an interesting employer in the region gives students the chance to find out about the types of employment opportunities available to graduates in their area, and provides students with a positive impression of living and working regionally.
- o The students ideally get a chance to tour a local organisation to get real world insight into how that business operates, and to talk to several employees working in different areas to expand their knowledge of different jobs. It also engages and supports local businesses and industry.

Key Learning Outcomes/Topics covered

- o Learn about a range of different jobs and career paths offered by an important local employer, and reflect on those of most personal interest.
